- Become familiar with the objectives of the youth sports program with which I am coaching.
- Uphold the authority of the officials who are assigned to my sport, and I will assist them, in every way, to conduct fair and impartial competitive games.
- Learn the strengths and weaknesses of my players so that I might place them into situations where they have a maximum opportunity to achieve success in practices and games while they improve their skill level.
- Protect the health and safety of my players.
- Adhere to all NCYFC and Beverly Panthers Rules & Regulations
- Be responsible for returning all property (equipment, books and paperwork, etc.) of the Beverly Panthers to administrators at the end of the season or earlier if requested.

*I authorize the NCYFC and Beverly Panthers to obtain, from any source, any information relevant to this application. I hereby authorize all sources to release such information to the NCYFC and Beverly Panthers. Beverly Panthers Code of Ethics

Youth sports programs play a key role in promoting the physical, social and emotional development of children. It is therefore essential for parents, coaches and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Moreover, adults involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect and self-control.

I therefore pledge to be responsible for my words and actions while attending, coaching, or participating in a youth sports event and shall conform my behavior to the following code of Conduct:

1. I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
2. I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
3. I will not use drugs or alcohol while at a youth sports event and will not attend, coach, officiate or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
4. I will treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
5. I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
6. I will not initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.

I hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, or participating in a youth sports event I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

1. Verbal warning issued by the league, organization
2. Written warning issued by the league, organization
3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a youth sports event issued by a league, organization or any official who is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection by the board or youth sports organization.
4. Removal from the league
